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FRANKLIN COUNTY MUNICIPAL COURT CLERK'S OFFICE Clerk Tyack's E-Pay Program Collects Over \$4.7 Million

The Franklin County Municipal Court Clerk's Office has collected over \$4.7 million in credit card payments over the internet.

The convenience of paying traffic tickets and fines online has been available since April, 2010. Since then, a total of \$4,772,842.60 has been collected, with an estimated merchant services fee savings of \$78,828.75. The average online transaction is \$166.50 with a convenience fee of \$3.50.

"This service has not only saved the City of Columbus money, but has saved our customers valuable time by allowing them to pay from anywhere in the world," said Clerk Lori M. Tyack. "When I took office in 2005, I promised the people of Franklin County that my office would improve efficiencies and save money and I am happy to say that this is another example of how we are working to fulfill this promise."

The convenience of paying traffic tickets and fines online not only provides a valuable service to the public but also saves taxpayers dollars. In addition, a Kiosk with direct access to the Clerk's website is strategically placed on the first floor of the Court Complex. The Kiosk provides a convenient online credit card payment option accessible 24/7 located at 373 S. High Street.
