Franklin County Municipal Court's Case History is now available on (OCN) Ohio Courts Network

After months of running history extracts followed by daily updates, the Franklin County Municipal Court's case history dating back to 1999, has been successfully integrated in the Ohio Courts Network.

"The Clerk's Office is pleased to participate in the Ohio Courts Network. The cooperative effort of sharing databases with other courts in the Ohio Courts Network provides an efficient platform for making Court case information available to all of our justice system partners Statewide. Being the largest Municipal Court in the State of Ohio, we realize the significance of sharing this valuable information and look forward to the day when every Court in Ohio is participating," said Lori M. Tyack, Clerk of the Franklin County Municipal Court.

The Franklin County Municipal Court Clerk's Office Case Management System sends data each night to the Supreme Court, which then integrates and securely stores this information. The records are made available to other courts and justice system partners such as the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation criminal history database and any case-related record from other local courts connected to the OCN.

The Ohio Court's Network was developed by the Supreme Court of Ohio. OCN serves as a centralized warehouse of case-related data to enable courts and justice system partners to share information. OCN supports functions such as criminal history reviews, warrant and protection order searches, pre-sentencing investigations, background checks and pre-custody reviews.
