The Franklin County Municipal Court Clerk's Office is currently offering attorneys the option to electronically file documents on existing Criminal and Traffic cases. Over 160 attorneys have already registered and are actively using the online E-Filing Portal, which went live on August 3<sup>rd</sup>. The general public may register to file documents, which may be reviewed and processed accordingly. If the filing is not accepted, the filer will be notified. "This portal saves time and increases safety by reducing face-to-face interaction between filers and the Clerk's Office staff, said Clerk Lori M. Tyack."

Registration requires a valid email address and for attorneys, their Ohio Supreme Court Registration Number. Documents such as Subsequent Filings, Notice of Appearance, Demand for Court, Demand to Jury, and Forty (40) other types of documents may be filed 24/7. Please note that documents filed after 4:00 p.m. will be processed the next regular business day.
