Clerk Tyack Hosts the Third License Reinstatement Workshop

Having a valid driver's license is more important now than ever before. Franklin County Municipal Clerk of Court, Lori Tyack, is hosting the third License Reinstatement Workshop to assist the public with getting their driving privileges reinstated. Clerk Tyack is hosting the event in the community at the Glenwood Community Center on October 24th from 9:00 to 4:30.

Based on 2022 statistics from the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles, there are 112,750 individuals currently suspended in Franklin County. Non-compliance and court ordered suspensions are two of the top five reasons individuals are currently suspended in Franklin County. The License reinstatement Workshop will be a one-stop location for individuals to address these issues.

Clerk Tyack prioritized having the event in the community to reach more people that cannot travel to several locations to reinstate their license. This collaboration will benefit both the individuals participating and the agencies providing services. "By working collaboratively, this workshop will give individuals the opportunity to finally clear up existing court cases, apply to have their reinstatement costs lowered or forgiven, and leave the workshop with a valid driver's license," said the Clerk. "This will definitely be a win-win for all."
